

PUTTING HARDWORKING PARENTS FIRST

More money for quicker treatments, new family hubs and more.

Parenting is tough. Balancing work and childcare is even tougher. That's why the UK Government is doing more to help parents, and is giving the Welsh Government the money to do the same.

We are making it simpler to help your child when they're sick, get support when you need it, and access more free childcare.

Pharmacies in England are now able to prescribe medication for seven of the most common conditions – including earaches, impetigo, sore throat and shingles.

So when your child is sick, you don't need to wait for a doctor's appointment or take a whole day off work. You can go to your local community pharmacy and get the treatment your child needs, when they need it.

And we want to see this rolled out in Wales. Including new family hubs for better access



to parenting services. This is why we're giving the Welsh Government record level of funding to do this, and more.

This comes on top of big changes to free childcare. In England, free childcare is being DOUBLED – giving families 30 hours a week of free childcare - from the time children are 9 months old to the time they start school. And in April this year the expansion began, meaning parents of two-year-olds now have 15 hours free. We're giving the Welsh Government the funding for this, it's up to them to match it.

Rishi Sunak has made it a priority to help parents balance work and childcare. And we're starting to make progress. So let's stick with the plan that's working.

ENSURE A BRIGHTER FUTURE FOR OUR YOUNG PEOPLE

I will fight for faster mobile and broadband connections and a Deeside Parkway railway station to ensure better access to new jobs. And I will also continue to champion farmers and small businesses for future generations.

The government was elected on a promise to level up investment in communities across the country. And Rishi Sunak is making it happen. Since 2019, the Conservatives have been investing £4.8 billion in regenerating high streets, tackling antisocial behaviour, restoring derelict buildings, rolling out gigabit broadband, supporting local businesses and introducing new freeports.

In and around Clwyd East, the UK Government is already investing over £30 million from the Levelling Up Fund on protecting and enhancing the heritage, culture and tourism offer in Ruthin, Llangollen, Denbigh and Prestatyn.

On top of that, more than £813,000 of funding secured from the UK Government's Community Ownership Fund is already helping to support key community hubs such as the Llandyrnog Community Shop, the Sun Inn in Eryrys, the Llangollen Museum and the Salusbury Arms in Tremeirchion. This will protect our vital community assets for future generations.

OUR ECONOMIC PLAN IS WORKING. LET'S STICK WITH IT

Inflation has more than halved. Wages are starting to rise. Mortgage rates are starting to fall. The government's plan is starting to work – let's not go back to square one.

It's been a tough few years for families across Britain. The pandemic caused economies across the world to slow down. The war in Ukraine caused prices to shoot up.

And now we face the global uncertainty of war in the Middle East.

The world faces serious challenges. That's why Rishi Sunak is determined to stick with the plan he set out, see it through and help families bounce back from a tough few years.

The good news is that since 2010 the UK has grown faster than Germany, France, Spain and Italy. And with inflation now down and

wages starting to rise, the plan is working – with much more to come...

- **Inflation has been more than halved** – from 11.1% in October 2022 to 4% now. That means our economy is starting to recover and the pressure on families is starting to ease.
- **Because inflation is down, the government pays less on debt.** That means we can afford to help families even more with the cost of living – and make sure work always pays.
- **So far, the government has cut National Insurance Contributions by hundreds of pounds.** For

someone on an average income of £35,000, their tax has been cut by £900 - meaning they keep hundreds of pounds more. This is good for families and good for economic growth and job creation, making sure that work always pays.

- **Wages are up, including the National Living Wage.** Because the Conservatives took the tough decisions to get spending under control, our economy is making progress and independent data is showing wages are starting to rise. That's why the government could afford to raise the National Living Wage – from £10.42 to £11.44 an hour.
