The Welsh NHS is failing. But it doesn't have to.

Shadow Welsh Health Minister sets out vision for NHS in Wales

It's no secret that the Welsh NHS is struggling. But do you know how it compares to the English NHS?

In the Welsh NHS, 25,569 people are waiting more than two years for treatment. In the English NHS, only 200 are.

In Wales, the Welsh Labour government cut the NHS budget. In England, the UK government increased it.

In Wales, there's a 50/50 chance of getting an ambulance in time. That's because Welsh ambulances are forced to wait outside hospitals until a bed is free. In England, response times are 20 minutes faster than a year ago. And £700 million is being invested in care outside hospitals to

ease pressure on the NHS.

Welsh Labour have been in charge of our NHS for almost 25 years. They want you to think it can't be improved.

But it can.

If the Welsh Conservatives are elected, their number-one priority will be to work with the UK government to fix our NHS.

That starts by increasing funding. Right now, Welsh Labour refuses to spend the full amount of funding given to them by the UK government. That's £500 million the Welsh NHS is missing out on.

So the Welsh Conservatives will increase spending. And they'll fix the bed crisis by working with

Occupational Health Therapists to help patients out of hospital beds and back into their homes.

If patients still need care, they'll be transferred to brand-new Care Hotels, staffed by an army of NHS reservists. These will be safe and monitored environments for those who can leave hospital but can't go home just yet.

This is a plan to free up bed space, end the two-year inhumane waits and fix our Welsh NHS.

We don't have to suffer through the failings of Welsh Labour. There is a better way. And together, with your support, we can take it.

- 207 more police officers in North Wales since 2019
- NEW Police base for Prestatyn town centre secured



Thanks to the UK Government's investment in police forces, the number of police officers in North Wales is the largest ever. Vale of Clwyd MP James Davies has been pushing North Wales Police to open a permanent base in Prestatyn town centre and to improve the facilities in Holywell police station. After meeting with James, the Chief Constable agreed in principle to open a new base in Prestatyn and recently it was confirmed that this will open later in 2024. A more visible police presence in the town will reduce anti-social behaviour and keep local people safe.



For too long patients and NHS staff in North Wales have been let down by Betsi Cadwaladr University Health Board and Labour ministers in the Welsh Government in Cardiff Bay. As a GP, local MP James Davies understands the key issues. A major problem, he says, is that because the NHS has been devolved for 25 years, health statistics are counted differently in Wales. That means poorer performance and outcomes are being hidden. James has secured top-level meetings to argue for new laws for UK-wide comparable statistics on NHS performance so that problem areas are exposed and standards are improved, meaning local people get the care they deserve.

Brits deserve quick and easy journeys. That's the message coming out of government, and they're putting their money where their mouth is.

Other politicians have wanted to duck the big decisions around HS2. But it has almost tripled in cost, while taking more than a decade longer than planned to finish.

That's why Rishi Sunak is cancelling the rest of HS2 and reinvesting every single penny in hundreds of new transport projects across the country.

One of these projects will invest £1 billion to electrify

the North Wales Main Line from Crewe and Warrington to Holyhead, meaning faster and more reliable journeys for commuters and holidaymakers.

This investment is on top of £390 million the UK Government has already invested into railway lines in Wales.

Railways in Wales are even more important now that the Welsh Government has imposed their "go slow" 20mph blanket speed limit in built-up areas, resulting in local bus routes being changed or scrapped.

The 20mph speed limit simply isn't working. And half a million people have said so, signing a petition against it.

But the Labour Government in Wales has ignored their views and ploughed ahead regardless. Dr James Davies MP and the Welsh Conservatives are keeping up the fight against this default limit but need your help.

Have you seen James' Plan for Clwyd East?

1 Improve the NHS in North Wales

Healthcare should not be a postcode lottery. I will continue to champion patient safety and challenge poor standards by exploring legislation that can deliver UK-wide comparable statistics on performance and outcomes. I have secured top-level meetings to help make this happen.

2 Advance multi-million pound bids to breathe new life into our High Streets

Tens of millions of pounds of UK Government 'Levelling Up' funding is already beginning to benefit communities such as Ruthin and Llangollen. I am proud of helping to lock in a formula for distribution of 'Shared Prosperity' funding which is generous to North Wales – giving our councils the ability to invest in local priorities.

3 Tackle crime and anti-social behaviour

I have secured a new town centre police station for Prestatyn and continue to campaign for improved facilities in Holywell. North Wales Police now have more officers than ever before but better visibility can provide reassurance and deter crime.

4 Improve transport across the region

I will continue to oppose the 20mph speed limit, work to implement the electrification of the North Wales mainline – for more frequent, faster, greener and more reliable trains – and push to improve A55 bottlenecks. I will also continue to press for maintained and improved local bus services, despite the impact of the 20mph policy.

5 Ensure a brighter future for young people

I will fight for fit-for-purpose gigabit and 5G connectivity and a new Deeside Parkway Railway station, to ensure better access to jobs and a bright future for Flintshire and Denbighshire. I am working with ministers across government to deliver on these priorities. I will also continue to champion farmers, small businesses and the tourism sector in their ongoing struggle against damaging Labour Welsh Government policies.

6 Maintain and enhance local quality of life and community pride

Working with local figures and businesses, I will ensure that local sports teams, charities, and community hubs, such as Theatr Clwyd in Mold, get the support they need. The Sun Inn, Eryrys and the Llangollen Museum are the latest to receive hundreds of thousands of pounds of support from the UK Community Ownership Fund. I will also work to protect and enhance our beautiful environment.

James is committed to supporting our local communities so they thrive and he has already delivered on several projects. A new Banking Hub in Prestatyn opened in December 2023 so local people have vital access to financial services. He helped the community buy-out of the Salusbury Arms in Tremeirchion by supporting their grant of £175,000 from the UK Government's Community Ownership Fund. And he assisted the reopening of the village shop in Llandyrnog by backing their grant for £180,000. But James knows there's more to do and is now turning his attention to helping Theatr Clwyd in Mold.



James, an NHS GP of 15 years, is leading the campaign for a public inquiry into the problems in Betsi Cadwaladr UHB. The NHS in other parts of the UK faces challenges but performs far better and more safely – despite Wales receiving 20% more funding per head. James is pressuring the Welsh Government to hold an independent public inquiry into the issues in BCUHB so that we can learn the lessons needed to improve outcomes for patients and give local people the care they deserve when they need it.


